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Tusk 2008 offers dark chocolate, violet, blackcurrant, sweet black truffles and espresso bean aromas. In tasting this unforgettable wine, the following words come to mind: Intense, powerful, opulent, sophisticated, superb velvety texture and ripe dark fruits. Extremely detailed grape sorting created even ripeness throughout fermentation. The extended finish is a sign of “grand vin”; it should age gracefully for many years.

Production: 150 cases

Varietal: Cabernet Sauvignon

Vineyards: 7 different vineyard sources, 5 Napa Valley appellations. Oakville and Prichard Hill are the primary sources.

Aging: 30 months in new French Oak

Bottling: March 2011 / Release: March 2012

Maturity: 20-25 years

Important: Tusk should be decanted and enjoyed at 60F-65F
