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2014 Tusk is an example of the best the 2014 vintage has to offer. It has classic, sweet, and ripe fruit characteristics. The nose is dark and purple, but the palate is red and light on it's feet. Loaded with finesse and subtle notes of gunpowder and quince, the structure is powerful for it's size and reminiscent of the great super Tuscan wines. Slow moving, like an underground river, the wine is always denser than it's weight, with a fascinating progression on the palate, offering glimpses of a stunning future, and leading into a mesmerizing finish that caresses the senses.

Production: 250 cases

Varietal: Cabernet Sauvignon

Vineyards: 7 different vineyard sources, 5 Napa Valley appellations. Oakville and Prichard Hill are the primary sources

Aging: 30 months in new French Oak

Bottling: January 2017 Release: March 2018

Maturity: 20-25 years

Important: Tusk should be decanted and enjoyed at 60F-65F
